Task Force Air Pollution and Noise

- Founded in December 2022
- Chairs: Anette Kocbach Bølling and Susanne Breitner-Bush
- Currently 35 members who meet approx. every 2 months
- The TF aims to bring together members who are assessing, or interested in assessing the burden of disease associated with air pollution and/or environmental noise.





Aims of Task Force

- Share experiences from calculation of (national) burden of disease estimates resulting from air pollution and environmental noise
- Support each other in calculations, model assumptions, and data gaps
- Harmonize methodologies and align strategies for communicating results
- Discuss and collaborate on concrete research projects
- Provide methodological input to the European Environmental Agency (EEA) for their calculations on air pollution (annual) and environmental noise (every five years)





Activities of TF

- Activity 1: Implementation of "FAIR" data and alternative exposure response functions for noise annoyance

- Activity 2: Commentary on change of air pollution estimates over time: Are air pollution health effects estimates reliable when they undergo abrupt changes?
